

Former Rhodes Resident Dies

RHODES — Guy D. Eastman, 81, Marshalltown former Rhodes area resident, died Friday, Apr. 4 at Community Hospital East, Marshalltown.

Services were held Monday in Marshalltown, with burial in Eden Cemetery at Rhodes.

Mr. Eastman was born Jan. 29, 1894 at Plankington, S.D., the son of Orville and Mary White Eastman. He came to the Rhodes area as a child and received his education there and at State Center.

His first marriage was to Marybelle Towles in 1918 in Rhodes. She preceded him in death in 1940. Two sisters also preceded him in death. His second marriage was to Stella P. Miller in 1954 in Plano, Tex. She survives as do two sons, Richard G. Eastman, Marshalltown, and Robert D. Eastman, Harrisonville, Mo., four grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Mr. Eastman farmed in the Rhodes area until moving to Marshalltown in 1937. He was employed there at the Tallcorn Hotel and as a carpenter. He moved to Texas in the early 1950s and back to Marshalltown in 1972.
