Mrs. Susie Isabelle Eddy, 79, State Center, died Saturday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Paul Benner where she had made her home for the past 10 years. Mrs. Eddy had been in failing health for the last three months.

Mrs. Eddy was born on July 7, 1875 in Story county the daughter of a pioneer family, Sevmore and Louisa Mumford Hix. At an early age the family moved to Nevada, where she grew up and received her education.

On Dec. 31, 1896, she married Frank S. Eddy at Nevada. He died in 1934. They lived for several years near Colo, later living in Nevada, Rhodes and Ames. In November, 1938 she remarried Dwight W. Eddy, who preceded her in death in 1945. Six brothers and one sister also preceded her in death.
