Funeral services for Chris D. Eggers, 82, of Marshalltown, former State Center area resident, were held at 10 a.m. Friday in State Center at St. Paul Lutheran Church. Rev. L.R. Meinecke officiated and burial was in Hillside Cemetery, State Center.

Mr. Eggers died Tuesday, Oct. 5 at Community Hospital West, Marshalltown.

Born May 12, 1889, he was the son of August and Sophia Busse Eggers.

He was reared and educated in Marshall County, attending the St. John's Lutheran School near State Center.

He moved to Marshalltown in 1937 and was employed at a local packing house prior to his retirement in 1962.
