Ralph Eggers, 88

Ralph Eggers, 88, a former Marshalltown resident, died Tuesday evening, Dec. 10, 2002, at the Milford Care Center in Milford, Iowa.

Graveside services were held Friday, Dec. 13 at the Hillside Cemetery in State Center with Pastor Mike Maddick officiating. Estel-Perrin-Avey Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Eggers was born in Marshall County on May 5, 1914 the son of Albert and Selma Frohwein Eggers. On June 14, 1934 he was united in marriage to Helen Weuve, she preceded him in death in November of 1993.

Raised and educated in rural State Center, he attended rural

schools in the area of his birth. Following their marriage, the Eggers farmed in the rural State Center area until 1972 when they retired and moved to Marshalltown.
