## Ryan Eldridge, 17, State Center

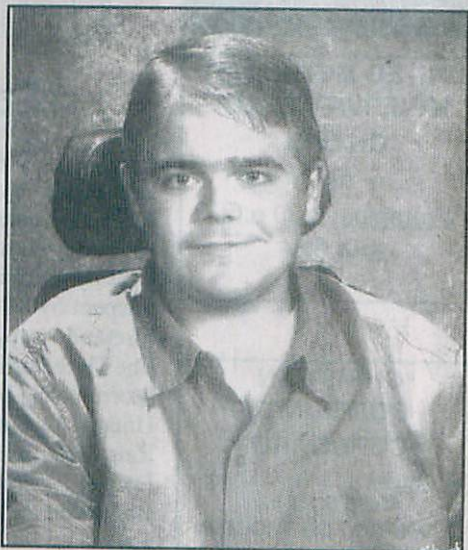
Ryan Eldridge, 17, of State Center, died Sunday, July 19th, at the Mercy Hospital in Mason City.
