## **William Elliott** **Died Sept. 19**

James William Elliott, eldest son of Zachariah and Elizabeth Elliott, was born in Greenfield, Ind. on April 1, 1854 and departed this life at his home in Cassville, Mo., on Sept. 19, 1939, aged 85 years, 5 months and 19 days.

His early life was spent in Story county, Iowa. As a young man he united with the United Brethren church and remained a faithful follower of God his entire life.

On Oct. 18, 1874 he was united in marriage to Martha Parker. To this union nine children were born. Two children preceded him in death. The wife and mother died in 1914. On Oct. 10, 1923 he was united in marriage to Mrs. Mae Edens of Cassville, Mo.

There remain to mourn his departure his wife and seven children: Harley Elliott, Cambridge, Ia.; Mrs. J. R. Hoffman, Maxwell, Ia.; Jesse W. Elliott, Salem, Ore.; Daniel W. Elliott, Augusta, Kan.; Mrs. A. C. Harrah, Hampton, Ia.; Mrs. Ed Talley, Independence, Kan.; Mrs. L. E. Gilbert, Mo.

One brother, Frank Elliott of Collins, Ia.; 29 grandchildren, 26 great grandchildren, a host of other relatives and friends also mourn his death.

Funeral services were held in Cassville, Mo., Wednesday, Sept. 20. The body was then brought to Maxwell where funeral services were held from the home of J. R. Hoffman at 1:30 p. m. Saturday, Sept. 23, with the Rev. Judson T. Perkins in charge. Burial was made in Evergreen cemetery at Collins.
