

Ethington, 76, Dies; Services Planned At Colo

COLO— Funeral services for Lindsay Ethington, 76, rural Colo, who died Thursday morning at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital, will be held Saturday at 1 p.m. at the Colo Methodist Church. The Rev. Harlan Babcock will officiate the services. Burial will be at the Colo Cemetery.
