## Obituary of Mrs. Chas. Evans

Effie Dell Evans was born in Jasper county, Iowa July 24th 1885 and died December 26th 1918, age 33 years, 5 months and 26 days. May 27th 1902 she was united in marriage to Charles W. Evans at Marshalltown, Iowa. To this union were born five children the youngest being five months old. She leaves to mourn her loss her husband, five children, her father and three sisters. Some time ago Mrs. Evans was taken down with influenza followed by pneumonia and heart trouble which caused her death. She with her husband had resided in the Spotted Tail neighborhood for seven years. She was always kind and active to help those in need and especially in time of sickness did she respond to urgent calls. She was highly respected by all who knew her and her many friends will mourn her loss.

She united with the Christian church when a girl later uniting with the friends church at Nevada where the family home was until about seven years ago. She has since made her church home with the Federated church at Mitchell, Nebraska.

Funeral services were held at the home of the deceased Saturday afternoon conducted by Rev. Walter C. Rundin pastor of the Federated church of Mitchell. Mesdames M. B. Quivey and E. C. Whitcock sang two selections. At the conclusion of the services the cortege proceeded to Mitchell where the body was placed on the train for shipment to Collins, Iowa where interment took place.

Funeral services were conducted in Collins in the family home of Mrs. Martha Evans. The relatives and friends gathered here to pay tribute to their loved one and esteemed friend. Rev. Fred Ingvaldstad spoke on 'The Resurrection.' Music was furnished by a quartette Mrs. Serbein, Miss Holmes, Mr. Witmer and Mr. Weese.
