

Evans, Harry L.

Harry Lloyd Evans, son of Calvin and Martha Evans, was born on a farm southeast of Collins, Iowa, Dec. 5, 1889, and departed this life at the Masonic sanitarium in Bettendorf, Iowa, Sept. 23, 1941, at the age of 51 years, 9 months and 18 days.

With the exception of four years in Melbourne, where he followed his trade of barbering, and the eight years preceding his passing at Bettendorf, his life was spent in the Collins community.

During his stay at Melbourne, he joined the Masonic lodge there and became a member of the Church of Christ. In 1921 he transferred his membership to the Collins Church of Christ, remaining faithfully in its membership until the time of his call.

On June 29, 1910, he was united in marriage to Lavon Patterson, and to this union one son, Donald, was born.

Surviving to mourn his passing are his son, Donald Evans of Chicago; one sister, Mrs. Addie Harsh of Des Moines; four brothers, Madison Evans of Pine Bluffs, Ark.; Charles Evans of Carlton, Ore., Will and Ray Evans of Collins, and a number of more distant relatives and a host of friends.
