Death at 6:45 Wednesday evening at State Center claimed George H. Falconer, aged 75, an old resident of State Center, and for many years a stock buyer for the firm of Capron & Dakin. Mr. Falconer's death was due to apoplexy with which he was stricken three weeks ago.

Born in New York State, Nov. 30, 1847, Mr. Falconer came to State Center in July, 1865, and has lived here ever since. In 1866 he was married to Miss Victoria Nale, who died July 24, 1896. A son born to the pair died in infancy.

No relatives other than a niece and nephew are known here. The niece, Mrs. M.M. Burns, lives at Sanborn, and the nephew, Roy Walker, in Havana, Cuba.

Mr. Falconer was a member of Terrestrial Lodge No. 276, A.F. and A.M., and the burial in Hillside cemetery Friday afternoon was with Masonic honors. Funeral services were held from the Presbyterian church at 2 o'clock in charge of Rev. G.C. Albright.
