Evelyn Catherine (Johnson) Farrell, 86 of Nevada died on Thursday, August 26, 2004 at Story County Medical Center in Nevada. Funeral services were held on Tuesday, August 31 at the Memorial Lutheran Church in Nevada with Pastor David Burling officiating. Burial was at the St. Paul Lutheran Cemetery in Lakota, Iowa.

Evelyn had also lived in Fort Dodge and Spirit Lake.

Evelyn is survived by 2 daughters, Peggy Lee Sell of Cedar Falls and Leola Jane Fain of Nevada; a sister, Darlene Geilenfeldt of Lakota; 7 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren.
