Crash injures one, takes life of another

An automobile accident on Hwy. 330 Saturday, Aug. 17 resulted in fatality and a major injury to a local resident. The accident happened at 1:30 p.m. about 8 1/2 miles north of Bondurant.

Charity Fazio, 19, a former West Marshall High School student, died in the accident while Linda Wignall, 45, Rhodes, was seriously injured. Both were transported to Mercy Hospital in Des Moines.

According to the Iowa State Patrol, Fazio was driving a 1994 Pontiac Sunbird and was apparently trying to pass when she drove over the center line and collided head-on with a 1997 Chevy Blazer driven by Wignall.

The accident remains under investigation.
