Word has been received of the death of Mrs. Eva Felshaw Kirkpatrick at her home in San Diego, Calif., Monday, Jan. 4. Funeral services were held Thursday, Jan. 7, and the body placed in a vault to await burial in the Collins cemetery by the side of her husband, J. S. Felshaw, and son Donald, some time in May.
