Ernest A. Frohwein dies after a long illness Death comes at home of his sister, Mrs. Henry Hunzelman June 8, 1933 State Center Enterprise

Ernest A. Frohwein, a well known resident of this community, died at 6:45 Tuesday morning at the home of his sister, Mrs. Henry Hunzelman of State Center. Death was caused by cancer. Mr. Frohwein, in November, 1931, underwent an operation for the removal of one leg, hoping to arrest the disease, but had become worse and had been bedfast since in January.

Mr. Frohwein was born here on May 15, 1902, and on Sept. 22, 1925, was united in marriage to Miss Ella Hannusch.

A six-year-old daughter, Wanda, and his widow survive. He is also survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Geo. Frohwein, three sister, Rosella, Mrs. Hunzelman and Mrs. Fred Eggers, all of State Center, and four brother, Louis and Harvey, of State Center and Fred and Earl of Gowrie, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock from the Henry Hunzelman home and at 2:00 o'clock from the St. John's Lutheran church northwest of town. Rev. Wm. J.F. Zabel will be in charge of the services and burial will be in Hillside cemetery.
