Mrs. Emma P. Fuller's Obituary.

Mrs. Fuller died at her home in Greencastle Sunday evening, January 3rd, at nine o'clock. The funeral was held at the house Wednesday morning.

Mrs. Emma Pearson Fuller was born in Indiana June 12, 1858 and came to Iowa with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. E. Pearson, in the sixties.

She was married to John W. Jennings July 3, 1882. To this union was born a daughter, Maude Viola. Mr. Jennings died March 5, 1884.

On May 3, 1887 occurred her marriage to William B. Fuller, and to them were born one daughter and two sons. The deceased had been a sufferer for several months previous to her death, which occurred Dec. 27th, 1914.

She was 56 years, 6 months and 15 days old at the time of her death.

Rev. Johnson of the M. E. church conducted the funeral services and interment was made in the Peoria cemetery.
