Howard Olaf Funnemark: January 16, 1923 - June 14, 2005 06/30/2005

WESLEY - Howard Olaf Funnemark, 82, died June 14 (2005), at the Algona Good Samaritan Care Center after a prolonged battle with cancer. Family grave site services were held at 6 p.m. on Thursday, June 16, at the Evergreen Cemetery in Wesley with Dr. Jes Tarp, former pastor of the Wesley Evangelical Free Church, officiating.
