Verlin Gale, 78, of Maxwell, died Monday at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames from leukemia. Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at Bacon Funeral Home in Maxwell with the Rev. Don Burkett officiating. Burial will be in Peoria Cemetery near Maxwell.

Verlin Gale was born Dec. 27, 1922, in Peace Valley, Mo., the son of Dudley and Charlotte (Roush) Gale. He graduated from Mountain View High School in Missouri in 1941. He served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. Following the war, he farmed in Conrad. He married Thelma Davis Sept. 17, 1950, near Maxwell. They lived on a farm near Maxwell until moving into Maxwell in 2000. He worked for the Iowa Department of

Transportation in Ames for 18 years. He was a member of Peoria United Methodist Church of Maxwell, the Maxwell V.F.W. and American Legion.

He is survived by his wife; two daughters, Gwen Nordholm of Maxwell and Jan Lee of Truro; and four grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by five brothers and one sister.
