

Services held Wednesday for D. German

Funeral services for Dwight E. German, 62, Marshalltown, were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday, Apr. 24 at the First Presbyterian Church in State Center, with Rev. Vernon Forsberg of Marshalltown in charge.

Pallbearers were Robert Liston, W.V. Van Pelt, George Speers, Delos Goodman, Joe Streeter and Paul Wilkening. Burial was in Hillside Cemetery, State Center.

Mr. German, who had been ill since November, died Saturday evening at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

On Oct. 21, 1933 he was married to Helen Gray. He was a member of the Elks Lodge at Marshalltown.

Surviving besides his wife are a son Dr. Robert German of Dallas, Tex., and two grandchildren. Also surviving are a sister, Mrs. Raymond Bishop of Des Moines and a brother, Ronald German of State Center.
