Robert Gibbs, Rhodes, Dies

STATE CENTER — Services for Robert C. Gibbs, 55, Rhodes, who died early Friday morning of a heart attack at his home, will be at 2 p.m. Monday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in State Center, in charge of the Rev. E. J. Braun. Burial will be in the Hillside Cemetery, in charge of the Wensel Funeral Home. Friends may call until 10 a.m. Monday.

HE WAS BORN July 3, 1899 in Boone County, Mo., the son of Walter and Nellie Burt Gibbs. He attended High school in Missouri and The University of Missouri in Columbia.

He was married Jan. 27, 1927, to Gertrude Schoppe at State Center. They made their home on a farm 5 miles west of State Center where they lived until retirement when they moved to Rhodes in 1954.

MR GIBBS WAS A member of IOOF and Rebekah Lodge No. 362 of Rhodes; Modern Woodmen and St. Paul's Episcopal Church. He was preceded in death by two brothers.

Surviving is the widow, a daughter, Nellie Ann, Marshalltown; sons, Marvin, State Center, and Pfc. Eugene Gibbs, stationed in Korea, three brothers, four sisters and a granddaughter.
