## MISS MARY GINGLES

The Collins community was grieved to learn of the death of Miss Mary Gingles at the Iowa Methodist hospital in Des Moines at 6:00 p.m. Friday. Miss Gingles was taken to the hospital last Wednesday following an illness of several months at her home in Collins.

Miss Gingles, only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. G. Gingles, was born in Collins, July 25, 1895. Following her graduation from the Collins high school in 1914, she took nurses training at the Iowa Methodist hospital in Des Moines, being graduated in 1918. For a year and a half she was assistant superintendent of nurses at the Methodist hospital and then entered private practice for 12 years. In 1932 Miss Gingles accepted a position with the Methodist hospital in Des Moines as night matron of the nurses home, continuing there until failing health compelled her to give up her work.

Miss Gingles is survived by her parents and a brother, George, of East Moline, Ill. She was a member of the Methodist church and the Order of Eastern Star.

Funeral services were held Monday at 2:00 at the Methodist Episcopal church in Collins, with Rev. C. E. Lookingbill of Nevada in charge. Interment in the Collins cemetery.
