Thomas W. Golden, 63, of rural Nevada died Tuesday, July 6, 2004 at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines, Iowa. Funeral services were held on Saturday, July 10, 2004 at Memorial Lutheran Church in Nevada with Pastor Myron D. Herzberg officiating. Burial followed services at Woodland Cemetery in Iowa Center, Iowa.

Thomas William Golden was born on August 10, 1940 in Nevada, Iowa to Leon Wallace and Jane (Bell) Golden. He was a 1958 graduate of Nevada High School and attended Colorado State in Fort Collins, Colorado. He served in the U.S. Army during the Viet Nam War from 1966-1968. On November 30, 1969, he married Sandra Kay Winterboer at the First English Lutheran Church in Spencer, Iowa. He was a lifelong resident of Story County. Tom was a farmer and he worked for the Iowa State Dairy Farm from 1985-1997. He was previously a member of the Lion's Club.
