G. W. Good Obituary

George Washington Good was born March 14th, 1852, in Holmes county, Ohio. Departed this life Dec. 29th, 1913, being 61 years, 9 months, 15 days old. In the year 1868 he went with his parents to Iowa, locating on a farm near Brooklyn. In the year 1882 he moved on his farm west of Rhodes where he resided until the time of his death. Was united in the bonds of matrimony to Mary Jane Sackett July 12, 1877. To this union were born three children: G. Irvin Monroe Good, George Washington Good, and Cora Belle Good, who with their mother are left to mourn a lov-

ing husband and a kind father. He also leaves three brothers and a sister, namely C. P. Good of Doby Springs, Okla., A. Good, and Mrs. J. N. Mead of Rhodes, Ia., and W. I. of Marshalltown, Iowa, also two grandchildren.

He was highly esteemed by all who knew him and his genial and kindly presence will be sadly missed.

The funeral was held at the M. E. church of Rhodes yesterday. The sermon was preached by Rev. F. McGlumphry of Collins. The interment was at the Rhodes Cemetery.
