#### **Former resident succumbs at Rhodes July 7, 1949 State Center Enterprise**

Mrs. Margaret Pfantz Goodman, 91, pioneer resident of this community passed away at her home in Rhodes Tuesday morning.

She was born near French Grove, north of State Center on Dec. 3, 1857, the daughter of Henry and Margaret Pfantz. She was united in marriage to John W. Goodman, Jan. (print unreadable—may be 15, 1889), at State Center. They observed their golden wedding anniversary in 1939. Mr. Goodman died in 1946.

She is survived by three sons, Joseph of Minnesota; George of Rhodes; A.J. of Milwaukee, Wisc.; a stepson, Dr. L.A. Goodman, Munster, Ind.; two daughters, Mrs. T.B. Malloy, Rhodes and Sister M. Rosaria, Clinton and a sister Angie Pfantz, Chicago; 20 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.
