Rollie D. Grady, 46, Melbourne, died Saturday, Nov. 30, 2002 at his home.

Services were held Thursday, Dec. 5, at the Estel-Perrin-Avey Chapel with Pastor Linda Schmidt officiating. Cremation followed the services and family burial rites will be held at a later date. A memorial fund is being established.
