

Robert Gray Dies At 80 In Colorado

Services for Robert E. Gray, 80, longtime resident of State Center, who died Monday at Denver, Colo., where he had lived the last year, will be Thursday at 1:30 p.m. at the First Presbyterian Church in State Center. The Rev. C. B. Willming will be in charge and burial will be in Eden Cemetery.

Mr. Gray was born on March 6, 1875, at Lisbon, the son of John and Anna Williamson Gray. He received his education in Rhodes where the family moved while he was a small child.

ON NOV. 14, 1903 he was married to Nellie Weeks at Rhodes where they lived for 10 years prior to moving to State Center where he was in business for the past 40 years. In 1952 he retired because of poor health.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Dwight German, 708½ W. Church St., and a son, Harold, Arvada, Colo. Other survivors include a brother, Lyall, Rhodes; three sisters, Mrs. Wilbur Secor, Melbourne; Mrs. Perry Secor, Ft. Dodge, and Mrs. Cooper Gray, Waynestown, Ind. Five grandchildren also survive. Mr. Gray was preceded in death by his wife in 1949 and two sisters in infancy.

HE WAS A member of the Presbyterian Church in State Center charter member of the Rhodes Masonic Lodge, and served several years on the State Center town council.
