James H. Green, 90, 1008 S. 11th Ave., died Saturday at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital.

Born Dec. 31, 1891, at Bluford, Ill., he was the son of John Robert and Lizzie Green. He lived with his father and step-mother Corry Green before coming to Iowa. He received his education in the area of his birth.

On Jan. 30, 1916, in Marshall county, he married Mae Oler. They farmed in the Rhodes and Melbourne area for many years before moving to Ames in 1940 where he worked at the Central Stores at the Iowa State University. After retirement and moving from Ames in 1969 he had made his home with his daughters.

Preceding him in death were his wife in 1967, two sisters, Myrtle Smith and Lelia Riemenschneider; so three half brothers.

Surviving are two daughters and two sons, Lois (Mrs. Clarence) Shill of Marshalltown, Marjory (Mrs. Russell) Grove of Gladbrook, Robert J. Green of Statesville, N.C. and Richard Green of Champaign, Ill. Also surviving are eight grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, one sister, Maude Adams of Anamosa; a half-sister Gladys Wood of Mount Vernon, Ill., and step-brother, Glen Green of Mount Vernon, Ill.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday from Estel-Perrin Chapel with the Rev. Dr. Weldon Whitenack of the First United Methodist Church officiating. Burial will be in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens. A memorial fund has been established.
