## Death of Former Pastor Of Peoria Church

The Rev. C. R. Green, 76, former pastor of the Peoria Methodist church south of Maxwell died at 4:20 a. m. last Thursday at a nursing home in Perry.

Funeral services were held at the Peoria church at 1:30 p. m. Saturday. The Rev. Thomas Kelly of Des Moines and the Rev. H. W. Artman of Marshalltown officiated. Burial in Peoria cemetery.

The Rev. Green and his wife had gone to spend the winter in the south, where the retired minister was taken ill. They returned home recently and the clergyman was taken to the Perry nursing home. They had lived in the Maxwell and Peoria communities a number of years.

Besides the wife, surviving are one son, Richard E., Maxwell; one daughter, Mrs. Basil (Charlotte) Caple, Maxwell; three grandsons; one brother, John, Maryville, Mo; and four sisters, Mrs. Ida Cox and Mrs. Ruth Cox, both of Maryville, Mo.; Mrs. May Anderson, Burke, S.
