Edward Frank Haley, 92, resident of Baxter since 1950, died Sunday at Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton.

Services were held at the Congregational Church in Baxter on Wednesday afternoon. The Rev. J.A. Thompson, minister of the church, conducted the services.
