F. Hennaman died Tuesday

**Well known resident of this community for many years passes away
November 10, 1927 *State Center Enterprise***

Fanuel Hennaman, a resident of State Center for many years and well known to the entire community, passed away at his home here at 8:15 Tuesday evening following an illness of several months. Mr. Hennaman had been in failing health much of the summer and had suffered a stroke affecting his left side about six weeks ago. He had been bedfast since Oct. 22.

Mr. Hennaman was born in Rock Island, Ill., August 11, 1858. At the age of 21 he came to State Center with his parents. He entered the brick manufacturing business here, continuing until 1914, when he opened a coal and building material yard.

On September 1, 1887, he was married to Miss Josephine Delaware, in Marshalltown. Mr. and Mrs. Hennaman were the parents of three children, two of whom, with Mrs. Hennaman survive. They are Mrs. L.S. LaCroix and Edward Hennaman, both of this city.

Funeral services were held from the Hennaman home this morning at 10 o'clock.
