Local merchant suffers stroke Friday morning July 6, 1933 State Center Enterprise

A.H. Hilleman, well known dry goods merchant of State Center for many years, suffered a stroke of apoplexy Friday morning, while at breakfast at his home in the south part of town. The resulting paralysis has been somewhat lessened and he is reported improved at this time.

Mr. Hilleman had been working in his garden in the early morning, and was apparently in his usual good health when the seizure came.
