Luther Hix Rites Held At Rhodes

RHODES — Funeral services for Luther F. Hix, 73, Rhodes, were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Rhodes United Methodist Church.

Mr. Hix died Sunday, Nov. 14 at the Marshall County Care Facility, where he had been three weeks.

The Rev. Nancy Nichols officiated at the services and burial was in Eden Cemetery. Pallbearers were Fred Cheville, Willard Thursby, John Haas, Kenneth Haas, Tom Borton and John Buck. Honorary bearers were Martin Richeson, Wayne Hildreth and Russell Buck.
