Fatal accident east of State Center

At approximately 7:40 PM on Thursday, May 1, a fatal accident occured at the intersection of Highway 30 and Fairman Avenue, just east of State Center.

A Ford Taurus traveling northbound on Fairman Avenue failed to yield at the stop sign and was struck by a semi-truck traveling westbound on Highway 30.

There were four people in the Taurus that was driven by 33-year old Steven Lindemann of State Center. Lindemann was taken by Mery One Helicopter to Des Moines. Jared Hoop, 25, of Melbourne was taken to Marshalltown. Nathan Sinclair and Brett Nissen, both of Marshalltown, were killed in the accident. None of the four passengers in the car were wearing their seatbelts.

The accident is still under investigation and charges are pending.
