Cyrus Huffaker, 77, Dies; Laid to Rest, Sunday, Oct. 11

Cyrus F. Huffaker, 77, of Rhodes, a former resident of northwest Jasper County, died Thursday at the Marshall County Hospital in Marshalltown.

Death was attributed to heart trouble.

Funeral services was at the Boyd-Nickell Funeral Home at 2 p.m. Sunday.

Burial was in Evergreen Cemetery in Collins.

He is survived by his wife, Winnie; two sons, Cecil of Baxter and Millard of Newton; two daughters, Mrs. Don (Frances) Wilson of Collins and Mrs. Lois Peters

of Helena, Mont.; 24 grandchildren; 55 great-grandchildren and four great great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother and two sisters.

The son of Jake and Jane Huffaker, he was born April 14, 1886 in Princeton, Ill., moving to Zearing with his parents as a child. He was educated in rural schools.

He was married to Winnie Johnson Oct. 20, 1904, in Rhodes.

After his marriage, he farmed in northwest Jasper County, retiring and moving to Rhodes in 1958.
