Wanda Jean Hutt, 85, of Ames, died Friday, March 7, at her home.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 11, at First United Methodist Church in Ames, with the Rev. Dan Stipp officiating. Burial will be in Ames Municipal Cemetery.

Wanda Jean Hutt was born Jan. 26, 1918, in Woodward, the daughter of Donald and Bessie (Weyer) Wright. She was a longtime Ames resident. She married Charles L. Hutt Dec. 5, 1937, in Missouri. She worked at the Ankeny Ordnance Plant during World War II. She worked as a dental assistant for Dr. Walters until her retirement in 1970. She was a member of First United Methodist Church and Order of the Eastern Star.
