Inez M. Frerichs, 96, of Collins, died Thursday, Feb. 3, at Israel Family Hospice House in Ames. Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday, Feb. 7, at the Collins United Methodist Church, with burial at the Evergreen Cemetery in Collins.
