

Death of Mrs. Moore's Sister

Mrs. C. H. Moore's sister, Mrs. Alveretta May Watkins Irvine, died at her home in Shipley, Nov. 24, aged 43 years, two months and six days. She leaves to mourn their loss her husband and two daughters. She was one of a family of ten children, four brothers and six sisters, the parents being dead. She is the first of the children to follow them to the grave. Another of the sisters is Mrs. George Heard of Meltonville. Mr. Heard was the first prefect of Sunbeam Lodge, Mystic Workers.
