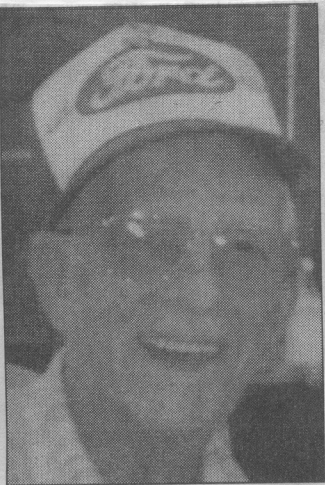

James M. Jackson, 75, of Ames, died Friday of a ruptured aneurysm at Mary Greeley Medical Center. Graveside services will be at 1 p.m. Wednesday in Allerton. Burial will be in Allerton Cemetery.

James M. Jackson was born on June 21, 1925, in High Point, the son of Walter and Edna Jackson. He had lived in Ames for 45 years. He married Beverly Laughlin on March 1, 1948, in Chariton. He worked as a coal man at the City of Ames Power Plant before retiring in 1962.

He is survived by his wife; two sons, Morris and Tom Jackson, both of Ames; three daughters, Jean Monahan of Collins, Donna Oliver of Cambridge and Ellen Deal of Ames, and 10 grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by two sisters.
