RHODES — (Special)— Mrs. Charles Walter Jackson 69, died at her home at 12:30 a.m. Friday of a heart attack she suffered Wednesday.

Services will be at 2 p. m. Monday at Rhodes Methodist Church. The Revs. E. H. Shuey and Kieth Hauser will officiate. Burial will be in Eden Cemetery.

The body will be taken from the Boyd-Nickel Funeral Home at Baxter to the Jackson home Sunday afternoon.

Mrs. Jackson was born at Rhodes Sept. 23, 1886, as Louisa Good, daughter of Abraham and Clara Good, and was married there Dec. 24, 1903.

She and her husband farmed north of Rhodes a year, at Sedalia, Mo., for 30 years and at Fayetteville, Ark., from 1934 until 1936, when they returned to the Rhodes vicinity. They retired and moved into town in 1949.

Surviving are the widower; a son, Samuel, Rhodes; a brother and three sisters, Maynard T. Good, Mrs. Arthur Crawford and Mrs. James White, Rhodes, and Mrs. Mary Jackson, State Center and three grandchildren.
