In 1950 after working as a foreman building ships in Portland, Oregon during WWII, Dean, along with his brother, started Jackson Brother's Garage on Main Street and owned & operated a truck line. He continued to work until his brother's death. Dean also drove a school bus for the Marshalltown Community Schools until retiring in 1984. Dean was a member of the Grace United Methodist Church, a 50 year plus member of the Marshall Masonic Lodge, No. 108 A.F. & A.M. and Order of the Eastern Star No. 400.
