Jake Jacobs

Dead At 72

Jake Jacobs, 72, former resident of the Rhodes community, who had made his home in Freeport, Ill., died in a city hospital Friday afternoon where he had been a patient since Tuesday. He had been in his usual health until his hospitalization.

Born July 25, 1886, in Foreston, Ill., he was the son of John and Anja Smith Jacobs, and the youngest of 12 children. He received his education and grew to manhood in Foreston, moving to Marshall County in 1906.

ON NOV. 12, 1912, in Rhodes, he was married to Phoebe Pyle. She preceded him in death in 1952. In September of 1952 in Freeport, Ill., he was married to Ida Wilkening and they have made their home in Freeport since. He was formerly a funeral director in Melbourne and Rhodes.

Mr. Jacobs was a member of the Latter Day Saints Church in Rhodes.

Preceding him in death were four brothers and seven sisters.

SURVIVING ARE the widow, a son, Kenneth of Green Mountain, a daughter Mrs. Reno Rethmeier of Newton, and three grandchildren; a brother, John of Foreston and numerous nieces and nephews.

Services will be from the chapel at Estel-Perrin Funeral Home at 1:30 p.m. Monday in charge of Elder Vick Lents, pastor of the Latter Day Saints Church. Burial will be in Eden Cemetery near Rhodes.
