John Jewell Dies Sunday At Age 87

BAXTER — Services for John Edward Jewell, 87, who died Sunday morning at Elmcrest Nursing Home at Des Moines of pneumonia, will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday from Rhodes Methodist Church in charge of the Rev. Lero Whiteside, pastor, and the Rev. A. D. Mohr of Ankeny.

Burial will be in Eden Cemetery at Rhodes. Boyd Nickel Funeral Home at Baxter is in charge of arrangements.

MR. JEWELL was born July 31, 1872 at St. Joseph, Mich. He was educated in rural schools in Michigan and moved to Rhodes in 1895.

He married Victoria Kuhns Sept. 25, 1897 at Rhodes, and they farmed near Rhodes until 1942, when they retired and moved to town.

MR. JEWELL fell last June and was hospitalized one month. He then made his home with a daughter, Mrs. A. D. Mohr, at Ankeny until Dec. 1, when he went to the Des Moines nursing home.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Mohr and Mrs. Kenneth Curran of Turlock, Calif.; three sons, Raymond Lester of Rhodes, Wesley Leroy of Grand Island, Neb., and Oscar David of Monterey Park, Calif.; a brother, Oscar of Marcellus, Mich.; a sister, Mrs. Ida Northrup of San Francisco, Calif., and 10 grandchildren.
