Rosemary E. Johnson, 84, of Villa del Sol Health Center in Marshalltown, died there on Sunday, March 23, 2003. FOLLOWING cremation at Pursel-Davis Crematory, Marshalltown, her cremated remains will be intered in the Forest Hill Cemetery in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin. Rosemary was born on January 3, 1919 in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, the daughter of Albert and Esther (Harmony) Ehnert. Raised and educated in the area of her birth, she graduated from Chippewa Falls High School. On December 12, 1938, she married Rolland E. Johnson in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin. They lived in Iowa City prior to moving to Marshalltown in 1953 and later to Union Grove Lake in 1983. She stayed

active with numerous civic activities. She was the past president of the New Comers Club and the League of Women Voters and served on the YWCA Board and the City Council. Rosemary was the first female to run for Mayor for the City of Marshalltown. Rosemary is survived by her husband: Rolland Johnson, of Marshalltown, sons Stephen (Pamela) Johnson, of Marshfield, Wisconsin and Richard (Emily) Johnson, of Richmond, Vermont, daughter: Janice (Mrs. David) Evans, of Des Moines, nine grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and one sister.
