Iowa State. Ed enlisted in the Army Air Force in August of 1941. He graduated from Armament school at Lowry Field, Denver Colorado and then from gunnery school in Las Vegas. He flew as a gunner for six months and then received his pilot's wings in July, 1943. He was a flight instructor for B 25's at Douglas, Arizona for 2 years. After the war he operated a G. J. Flight Instructor School for 2 years at Elkader, Iowa. Ed married Carol Fitz on March 7, 1943 at the Laurel Methodist Church. From 1949 to 1993 Ed and Carol farmed south of Van Cleve where being a good steward of the land was important to them. From 1968 to 1984 they operated the E Bar J Farm Supply in Baxter. He was a member of the Laurel Methodist Church and Laurel American Legion Harold McBroom Post # 638. He loved fishing in Canada with his friends and family Ed is survived by: wife, Carol Jontz of Marshalltown; daughter, Barb (Jerry) Gazaway of Marshalltown, Janie (Rick) Sherman of Deming, New Mexico, Julie (Steve) Lang of Marshalltown.
