

Dr. Kauffman *July 29 - 55* Dies Friday;

Rites Monday

Dr. W. A. Kauffman, 81, 3 E Grant St died at 1:35 p. m. Friday at the Evangelical Hospital where he was taken Thursday night. Death was due to complications of old age.

Born July 24, 1874, near Whitten, Dr. Kauffman was the youngest of ten children of Charles P. and Catherine Edleman Kauffman. On Sept. 28, 1898 he was married to Gertrude Lockard, Union.

HE ATTENDED Western College, Toledo, Iowa, and later graduated from the State University of Iowa Medical School.

Dr. Kauffman practiced at Conrad for more than 20 years. He then attended the Chicago School of Optometry and later opened an office at 4 E. Main in Marshalltown as an oculist.

He was a birthright member of the Quaker Church. For 50 years he was member of the Marshalltown Elks Lodge and the Roman Masonic Lodge at Conrad. In October, 1951, he was given special recognition and a 50-year pin by the Conrad organization. He had also been presented with a 50-year pin by the Iowa Medical Association.

DR. KAUFFMAN is survived by his widow, and a nephew, Dr. T. J. Roemer, Portland, Ore. who was raised in the Kauffman home.

Funeral services will be at . p. m. Monday at the Friends Church. Burial will be in Riverside Cemetery. The Pursel-Davis Funeral Home is in charge.
