

J. L. Kelderhouse Funeral
Held at Iowa Falls

The following, from an Iowa Falls paper, tells of the funeral services for the late J. L. Kelderhouse, a former resident of this community:

Funeral services for John Leonard Kelderhouse, 68, were conducted last Thursday afternoon from the Wood funeral chapel by the Rev. W.E. Butler.

Mr. Kelderhouse died at his home north of Iowa Falls Tuesday morning following a two-year illness. Burial was in Union cemetery.

Born February 6, 1871, at Rockford, Minn., the son of John Levi and Georgiana Elizabeth Kelderhouse, he came to Iowa with his parents when nine years old. He was married May 1, 1898, to Miss Minnie Tordoff at Cedar Rapids, settling in Story county, where they lived until 1918, when they moved to their present home.

Surviving, in addition to Mrs. Kelderhouse, are two sons, Alfred, of Denver, Colo., and Walter at home; two daughters, Mrs. Clara Eldridge of Owasa, and Elma of Deleware, Ohio; two grandsons, Dale and Walter Lee Eldridge; a sister, Mrs. Mary Drake of Marion; a brother, Austin of Collins, and several nieces and nephews.
