Collision kills Collins woman today

A car-truck collision on Iowa highway 210 one mile east of Cambridge by Skunk River Bridge No. 1, resulted in the death of a Collins woman, 8:30 a.m. today.

Anne B. Kern, 61, Collins, died instantly of multiple injuries she received when her 1965 Buick, westbound on Iowa 210, skidded on ice and slid broadside into an eastbound 1965 GMC milk truck.

The driver of the truck, Leland W. Christensen, 53, Des Moines, was not injured. An estimated \$1000 damage was done to the truck's left front.
