Funeral services were conducted Sunday afternoon in the home for the late Charles H. Kimberley, who died early last Thursday morning at the Deaconess hospital in Marshalltown. The Rev. C. E. Lookingbill officiated. Interment was in the Peoria cemetery by the side of his wife.

Charles Henry Kimberley, son of Isaiah and Mary Ann Kimberley, was born at the old Kimberley farm November 30, 1867, and died April 21, 1949, at the Deaconess hospital in Marshalltown at the age of 81 years, 4 months and 21 days.

His entire life was spent on the same farm and he took deep pleasure in improving and caring for the place.

On April 17, 1910, Mr. Kimberley was united in marriage to Daisy Pearl Nowning, who preceded him in death in February, 1927.

To this union four children were born: George and Charles of Collins, William of Colfax and Daisy Mary Bulard of Maxwell. There are five grandchildren.

Besides the children and grandchildren, he is survived by one sister, Mrs. Ruth Pearson of Maxwell, and there are many nieces, nephews and friends.

Mr. Kimberley took a keen interest in community affairs and enjoyed traveling. For the past ten years he has spent the winters in Florida and Arizona.
