

John Kimberley, 77, Dies

John I. Kimberley, 77 of rural Collins, died Saturday the result of an automobile accident five miles southeast of Collins.

Funeral services were held Tuesday at the Collins Methodist Church with Rev. Wilton Grant in charge. Burial was in the Peoria Cemetery.

Survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Bowers, three grandchildren, Mrs. Bill (Karol) Waterhouse, Mrs. William (Sharon) Thompson and Miss Connie Bowers, one great grandchild, Tracy Lynn Waterhouse, two brothers, J.
