## Obituary of Warren A. Kitchell.

The funeral of Warren A. Kitchell was held in the Christian Church of Collins yesterday afternoon. Rev. L. A. Fleming preached the sermon, preceding which he read the following short biography of the deceased:

"We are called to pay the last tribute of respect to Warren A. Kitchell. He was born in Story County, Iowa, Jan. 29, 1898 and departed this life Dec. 13, 1915, in Hancock county, Iowa, age 17 years, 10 months and 16 days. He leaves to mourn their loss, his father, mother, one brother, two sisters, four grandparents and many relatives and

friends, one sister having gone on before. He was a great sufferer for two years, having had tuberculosis. He was patient and showed a Christian spirit unto the last. His mother pointed him to the lord by singing and prayer."

The singing of the choir was comforting to the bereaved ones. The floral tributes were beautiful. Rev. Fleming preached a sermon conveying hope and comfort to the stricken parents and others bound to deceased by ties of kinship and friendship.

Deceased was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Ed Kitchell, who have the sympathy of their former neighbors and friends in this bereavement.

The interment was at Collins Cemetery, the pall bearers being cousins of deceased, viz: Amos Dodd, Floyd Dodd, Henry Dodd, Earl Dodd, Vern Dodd and Chas. Evans.

Note.—The body was brought from Hancock County to Collins Monday.
