Word has been received by Ada Knoll at Nevada that Rahamma Knepper Chritchfield and Margaret Knepper, sisters of the late Dr. N. W. Knepper, departed this life within a few days of each other. Mrs. Chritchfield passed away on Jan. 30 and Miss Margaret Knepper, Feb. 5. The latter had been in very poor health for more than two years. She taught the Collins school in the old one room building over 50 years ago, also taught in Berlin. Many of her pupils around Collins will recall those days.

Mrs. Chritchfield also taught awhile in Jasper county, and also at what used to be called the Sibly school.

The East was home to them and called for their interests, hence, they soon returned there, leaving many friends here.

Another sister, Cevilla Weigle, died in May of this last year.

Nell Knepper, the only sister of Dr. Knepper who did not come west, together with Margaret were the ones who cared for Fred Knepper, the invalid son of Dr. and Effie Knepper.

Nell is at present very sick after her long and faithful care of her sisters. She is the last of the Knepper family.
